

Parental Requirements

PTF MEETINGS

Parent - Teacher meetings are scheduled on the same day report cards go home. At least one parent is REQUIRED to attend each meeting for the benefit of his child and to obtain pertinent information concerning the school program. There will also be a presentation given by the teacher of what your child has covered and what he will cover during the coming grading period. Remember, these meetings are important to you and failure to attend these meetings may result in EXPULSION of your child from school.

PROGRESS REPORTS and CONFERENCES

In order for you to know firsthand of your child's progress, progress report slips are sent home every third week on Thursday. Slips are to be returned to the homeroom teacher by Friday for students in all grades. In the event that these papers need to be observed by a parent that did not have the opportunity to observe the papers they must still be returned on the following school day; however, a note should accompany the papers requesting they be returned on another date for the absent parent to observe them. Our only recourse regarding this matter is with the student, so please do your part as a parent.

All problems or questions concerning school rules and policies should be discussed with the administration, not the teacher. Please do not call teachers at their homes.
