

# Dress Code

## GIRLS

Since dress has a direct affect on attitude and building character, girls are expected to dress modestly and in appropriate attire. Skirts must fit comfortably. Blue Jean skirts may be worn in grades K4-6th. Some types of denim jumpers and skirts are permitted in the 7th - 12th, but must not be faded or too casual in appearance at the discretion of the administration).

The skirt must be long enough to touch the floor all the way around when the girl is in an upright kneeling position. If when sitting the skirt rides up beyond the knee, the skirt is either too short or too tight and may not be worn. Dresses or skirts with slits above the knee are not to be worn. Dresses or skirts, which have been manufactured with slits, must be sewn, not tacked or pinned.

Slacks or pants and pantsuits are not allowed. If added clothing is necessary due to severe weather, girls must change before classes start.

Dresses, blouses, sweaters, and jumpers with low-neck lines in front or below the middle of the back are not permitted without a shirt beneath. Dresses, blouses, sweaters, and jumpers with excessively large arm openings are not to be worn without a full shirt beneath; tank tops do not fit the criteria of a full shirt.

Gym clothes for girls are to be culottes, blouse, and gym shoes. Culottes are loose fitting in the back with legs that are flared. The hemline must be as in standard dress. The wearing of jams, shorts, sweat pants, slacks, etc. is not allowed.

Hair must be neat and modestly styled. Beaded hairstyles are unacceptable. Jr. and Sr. High girls may wear light make-up and blush, but no eye shadow or eyeliner. Ears ONLY may be pierced and no more than 2 holes per ear.

T-shirts with printed statements or pictures are not allowed; other style tops with statements or pictures are allowed at the discretion of the administration.

## BOYS

Hair: The three acceptable hair styles for boys will be - butch, flat top, or a left or right straight part; no closer to the middle of the head than the center of the eye. "Mod" or "fad" hair styles are not allowed.

Sideburns are to be no longer than to the middle of the ear and boys are to appear "CLEAN SHAVIN'" at all times.

Boys are expected to be well groomed and to dress neatly in appropriate attire. Blue jeans are acceptable through sixth grade. All shirts must be tucked in and have collars. Gym shoes for classes will only be acceptable up to grade six. Belts are required with pants made for them.

Only slacks, (not blue jeans) will be acceptable in grades 7th - 12th and must fit comfortably. We suggest casual slacks or dress trousers for the upper grades. Boys may not wear pants with pockets on the sides of the legs or with elastic around the bottom. They may not wear their pants folded around the bottom.
