

PARENT - STUDENT DRIVE IN PROCEDURE

In order to insure the safety of all Calvary Academy students, we insist on a few regulations concerning students who leave in private cars.

1. All passenger cars will arrive and depart by the front doors.
2. All cars must drive around the circle in a counter-clockwise formation.
3. All students are instructed to walk to the cars only after the car has completely stopped and the teacher has dismissed them. At no time will students be permitted to walk between cars waiting in line or through the parking lot.
4. Students are instructed to stand in the building until their car is recognized and in line. At that time, the teacher will call their name so that in the event of ice conditions, a car skidding would still be a safe distance from the children waiting.
5. After a car stops completely, the children will be allowed to get in the car only in front of the entrance.
6. If parents must visit a teacher or wait for any reason, park in the front parking area and use the front doors. Students must still exit through the car line dismissal.
7. Students who drive to school are to be dismissed by the teacher before leaving through the auditorium doors. If other students are riding with them they must pick them up in that car line.

STUDENT CARS and VEHICLES

Students planning to drive to school must seek written permission from the administration first, secure a registration form from the school office, and show proof of insurance. Only members of the immediate family will be allowed to ride in cars. No other students may do so. Exceptions must be checked with the administration.
