

CHAPEL

One day per week is set aside for a Chapel service at Calvary Academy. Every Chapel service is opened to the school and church public. Chapel consists of songs, character stories, Bible lessons, guest speakers, and student participation by class or individually through special music, scripture reading, testimonies, etc. Chapel is held each Friday.

SNOW DAYS

STUDENT EMPLOYMENT (Work permits, releases, and policy)

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania work permits are available at the school office for eligible students.

No students will be allowed to leave during school hours for employment reasons.

FIELD TRIPS

One means of supplementing our educational program at Calvary Academy is through the field trip. Although the majority of our field trips will place heavy emphasis upon academic pursuits, some will not; however, all field trips will enhance the child's total educational development.

CANDY SALE

The 7TH - 12TH grades hold an annual candy sale each year. All students are required to participate to be eligible for their class trip. The dates will be announced well in advance. Proceeds from the candy sale go toward the Jr. and Sr. High annual trips.

LUNCH

Limited sandwiches and vending machines are available to the students. Milk may be purchased by the semester and daily - 30 cents per day and \$25.00 per semester.

If a student forgets his lunch, the teacher may ask others to share the first time only.

If a student forgets to order his lunch in the AM, they will not be permitted to order at lunchtime, unless they receive permission from their homeroom teacher.

HEALTH

We are only able to administer simple first aid to students who need immediate but minor medical attention. Any student, who needs more medical attention, may be taken by private vehicle to the Butler Hospital. Only in extreme emergency situations will an ambulance be called.

PICTURES

Individual, class, and school pictures will be taken each school year. Students are required to have their picture taken for yearbook purposes. Boys must have fresh haircuts.
